

PROTOCOLOF THE MILITARY COLLABORATION BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE
REPUBLIC OF CUBA AND THE PEOPLE'S REVOLUTIONARY GOVERNMENT-
OF GRENADA

The Government of the Republic of Cuba and People's Revolutionary Government of Grenada, in full exercise of their sovereign right as free and independent State, based on the fraternal relations existing between both countries with the aim of making a contribution to the strengthening of the defensive capacity of Grenada, have agreed upon the following:

ARTICLE I

The Government of the Republic of Cuba in agreement with the request formulated by the People's Revolutionary Government of Grenada, will maintain Cuban Military specialists in that country in quantities and specialists established in Annex No. 1 - of this document. (Protocol).

ARTICLE II

The Military specialists from Cuba in behalf of strengthening the military capacity of the Armed Forces will assist grenadian military men on the questions of Organization of the Organic Structure, Organization of the Instruction and combative and campaign training of the troops and staffs in the preparation of cadres and minor specialists, and in the elaboration of the operative and mobilization plans for the defense of the country.

ARTICLE III

The Government of the Republic of Cuba will grant scholarships to military personnel of Grenada in the Military Training Centres of the Revolutionary Armed Forces with the quantities - and specialist with the requirements that will be established in Annex No. 3 which will be elaborated afterwards.

ARTICLE IV

The Government of the Republic of Cuba has the pleasure of receiving during 1982 four delegations of the Armed Forces of up to three members each, of the following specialities:

- Engineering, (the fourth-three months period)
- Communication, (the first three-months period)
- Logistics, (the first three-month period)
- Exploration, (the fourth three-month period)

The dates in which these delegations should travel to Cuba will be communicated to the grenadian side, by the cuban side twenty days in advance.

ARTICLE V

In order to lead the activities of the Cuban Military Specialists, the post of chief of the Cuban Military Specialists is established who will develop functions in the Ministry of Defense.

ARTICLE VI

The Cuban side according to the plans approved by its governments will carry out the systematic change of Cuban Military specialists in the quantities foreseen in the present Protocol.

ARTICLE VII

The People's Revolutionary Government of Grenada will give facilities to the chief of the Cuban Military specialists in the work places and for using the communication means existing in the country in order to assure the direction of his activities of Technical Military assistance to the Armed Forces.

ARTICLE VIII

The Cuban and grenadian Military specialists who in virtue of the present Protocol are in the Republic of Cuba or in Grenada will respect the sovereignty and customs and will observe the laws.

ARTICLE IX

The People's Revolutionary Government will give facilities to the Ministry of the Revolutionary Armed Forces of the Republic of Cuba to check the work of the Cuban Military Specialists.

ARTICLE X

The medical, technical and material assurance and the expenses as a result of the permanency of the Cuban Military Specialists on the Granadian territory will be implemented according to the time period established in Annex No. 2 of this Protocol.

ARTICLE XI

The People's Revolutionary Government will pay the expenses of the Custom-House and fees of the means sent to the Cuban Military specialists, by sea and by air.

ARTICLE XII

The Government of the Republic of Cuba and the People's Revolutionary Government of Grenada, will take all measures depending on them in order to assure the secrecy of the permanency of the military personnel in both states and the character of the activities, as well as the mail and information related to the present Protocol.

ARTICLE XIII

Any kind of situation that comes out in respect to the present Protocol or its accomplishment, it will be solved by friendly conversations between representatives of both sides in Havana City or in the City St. George's.

Any charges or additions to the Present Protocol will only be effective in case they are elaborated in a written way and signed by authorized personnel of both sides.




ARTICLE XV

ATTACH No. 2PROTOCOL OF THE MILITARY COLLABORATION ABOUT THE MATERIAL
MEANS, SERVICE AND ASSURING PERSONNEL.

The Government of the Republic of Cuba and the People's Revolutionary Government of Grenada agree to guarantee the material, technical and medical assurance of the Cuban Military Specialists according to the time period mentioned below:

CLAUSE No. 1

The People's Revolutionary Government of Grenada will guarantee the material means, equipments and the following services:

- a) Maintenance of furniture and properties sent and constructed by Cuba and those given by the country to the Cuban military personnel.
- b) Equipment and office material for the usage of the Cuban military specialists.
- c) Fresh food-stuff for the feeding of the Cuban Military personnel.
- d) The necessary transport means for the development of their functions inside the Armed Forces, guaranteeing the fuel and lubricants, its maintenance and repair.
- e) Armament and ammunition for the Cuban Military specialists.
- f) Qualifield medical assistance in the Hospital of the country as well as the necessary medicines for disease prevention and the maintenance of health of the Cuban Military Specialists.
- g) Means of personnel hygiene of every kind.
- h) National transportation required for the accomplishment of the service activities.
- i) Public Services (water, electricity, telephones and others)
- j) A small stipendium for the personal expenses of every members equivalent to (30) U.S. Dollars.

- k) Entrance visa and Identification Documents which accredit them for the civilian and military authorities of the — country.
- l) Personnel that guarantee the driving and usage of the transport Technique; the elaboration of food, washing and ironing of the clothes, the cleaning of furniture and properties and the security of the house.
- ll) Other means and services non-specified which are required - for the development of the work of the Cuban Military personnel.

CLAUSE No. 2

The Government of the Republic of Cuba will guarantee the means equipment and services we mention as follows:

- a) The sending of technical personnel, material means and necessary furnitures for the construction of the necessary installation for the living conditions and work of the Cuban - Military Personnel.
 - b) Dried foodstuff of every kind for the feeding of the Cuban-Military Personnel.
 - c) The trip clothes of the Cuban Military Specialists.
 - d) The necessary consultive material for the execution of the functions of the Cuban Military Specialists.
 - e) The salary in Cuba of the Military Personnel.
